

Ticketing Rules

- 1 Standard tickets are applicable to individual visitors who are not eligible for concessionary tickets.
- 2 Concessionary tickets are applicable to full-time students, people with disabilities (and one accompanying carer) and senior citizens aged 60 or above (Patrons may need to produce identity proof upon request by the museum staff before admission).
- 3 Group tickets are applicable to every purchase of 20 tickets or more.
- 4 Free admission for babies and toddlers below the age of 4.
- 5 All registered kindergartens, primary schools, secondary schools, post-secondary institutions, universities, charitable and non-profit-making organizations with a group of 20 or more are welcome to apply in writing for waiver of admission charges. All applications should be made at least two weeks before the date of visit.
- 6 All registered special schools, non-profit-making organizations of elderly, rehabilitation services and people with disabilities with a group of 10 or more are welcome to apply in writing for waiver of admission charges. All applications should be made at least two weeks before the date of visit.
- 7 Standard, Concessionary and Group ticket holders are eligible for admission to the Special Exhibition of the Hong Kong Museum of History once only.
- 8 Museum Pass holders can enjoy unlimited admission to the Permanent and Special Exhibitions (unless otherwise specified) of the Museums under the Leisure and Cultural Services Department during the validity period of the Pass.
- 9 Please also read the rules and conditions printed at the back of the tickets / passes for admission.
- 10 Please tender the exact amount. Credit card and cheques will not be accepted.
- 11 Please check your changes and tickets before leaving the Box Office, the Museum will not entertain disputes afterwards.
- 12 Tickets / Passes sold are non-returnable and non-refundable.
- 13 The Box Office will be closed 30 minutes before the Museum closes.
