

The 15th Best Ten National Museum Exhibition Selections (2017) Award

Jointly presented by the State Administration of Cultural Heritage and the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, and co-ordinated by the Hong Kong Museum of History and Shaanxi Cultural Heritage Promotion Center, the *Miles upon Miles: World Heritage along the Silk Road* exhibition was well received by the general public. The exhibition, which was staged at our Museum from 29 November 2017 to 5 March 2018, attracted more than 100,000 visitors. We were all very pleased with this encouraging response. To top it all, the exhibition has recently received the “International and Hong Kong-Macao Cooperation Award” from the 15th Best Ten National Museum Exhibition Selections (2017).
